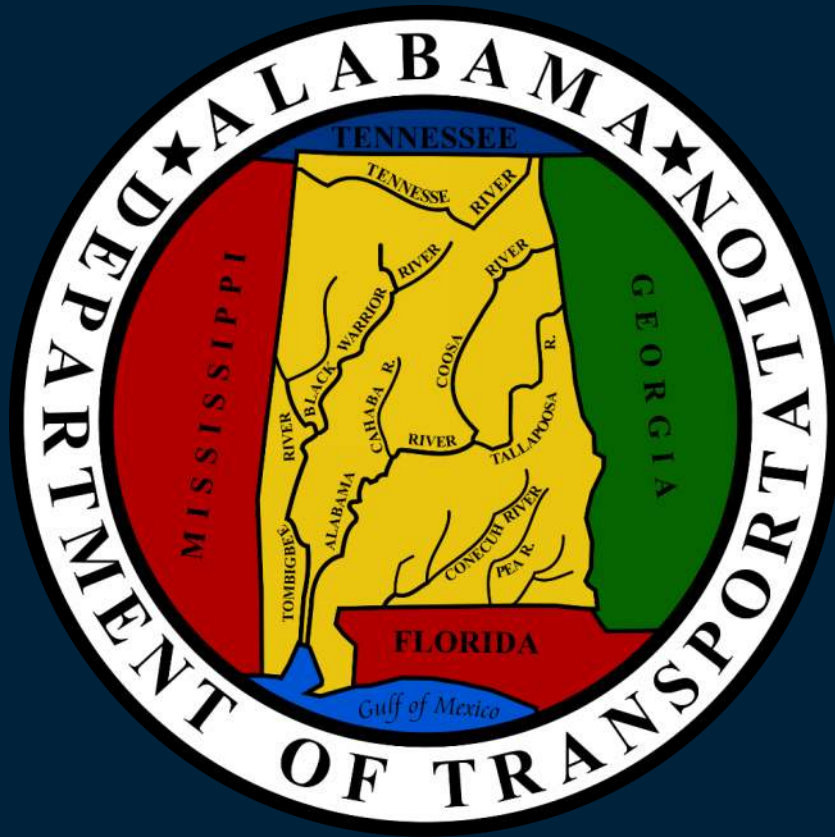

- Designed in the 1960's, with a 30 year lifespan and an 80,000 vehicles per day traffic count
- 60 years later the daily traffic counts exceed 165,000 vehicles, and is expected to increase. Portions of the roadway are falling apart.

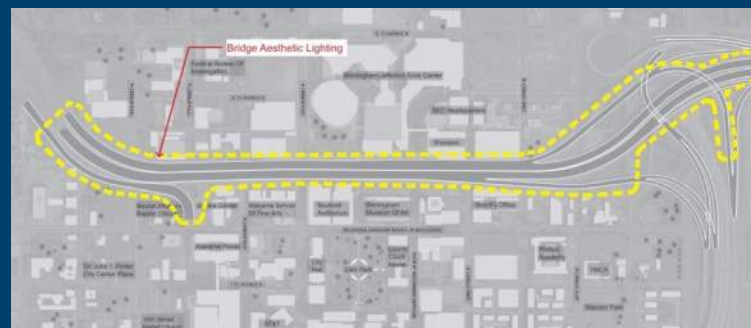

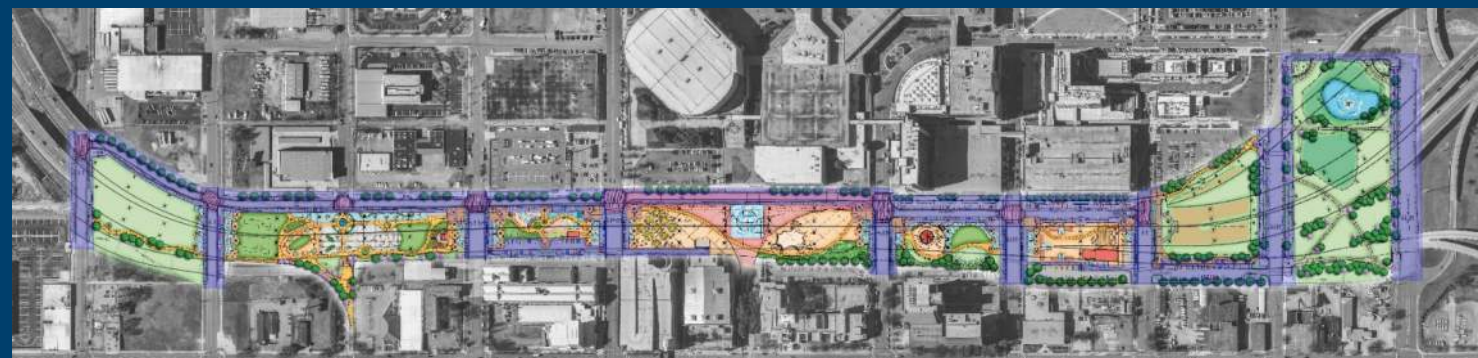

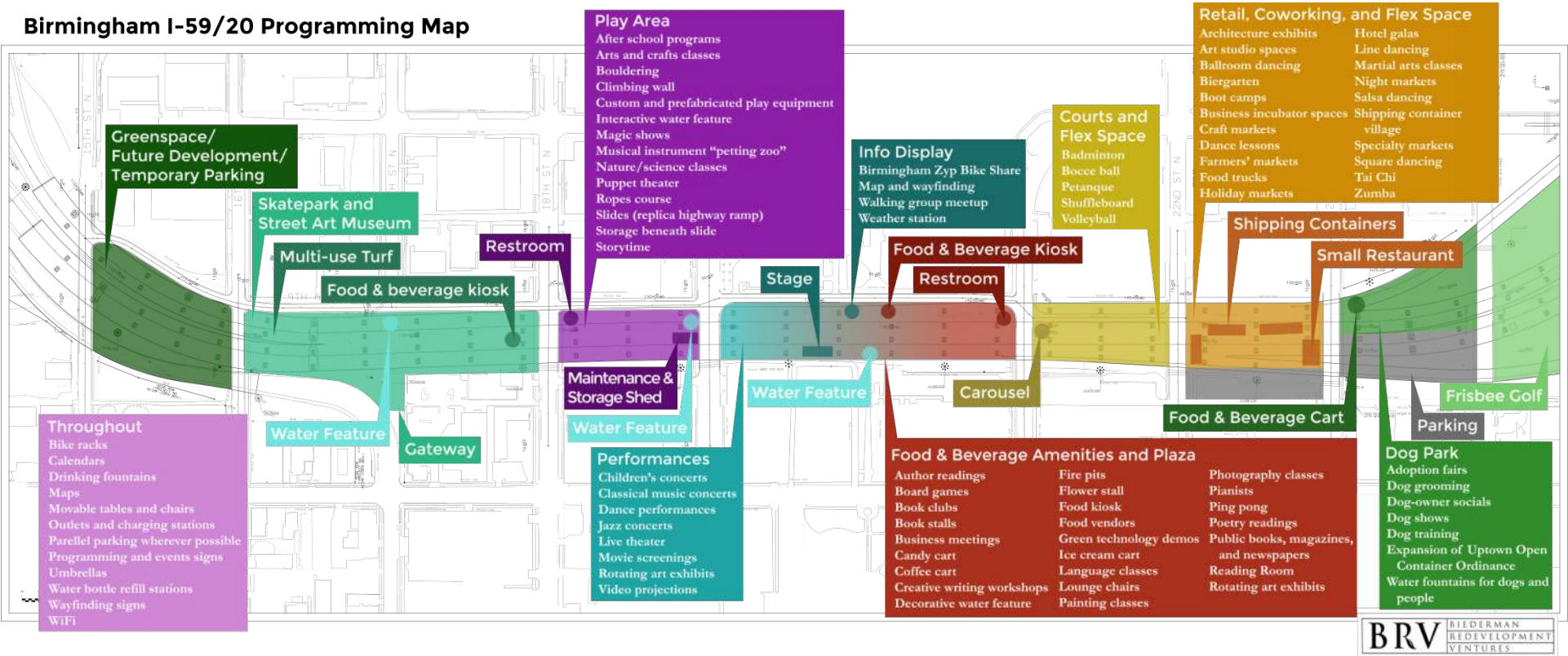

Birmingham I-59/20 Programming Map

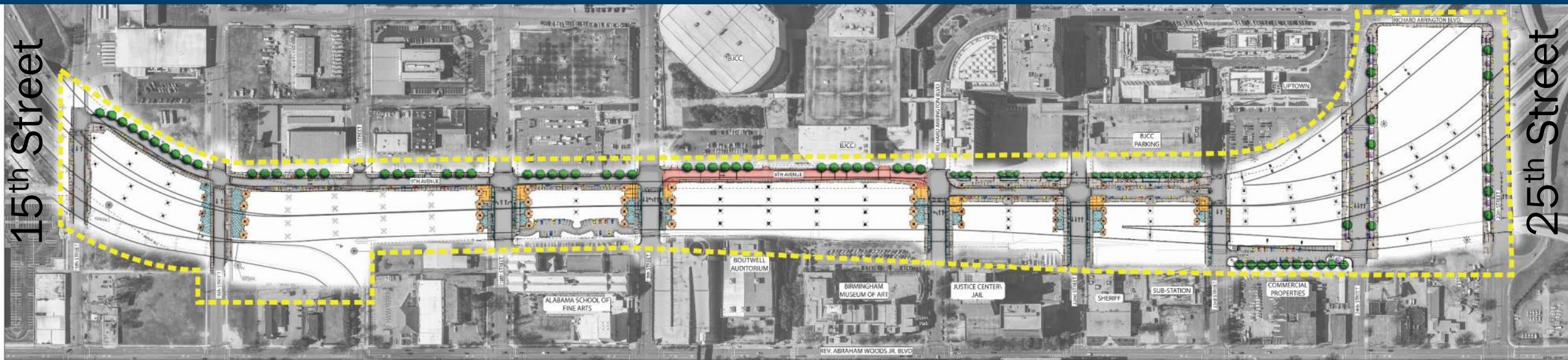

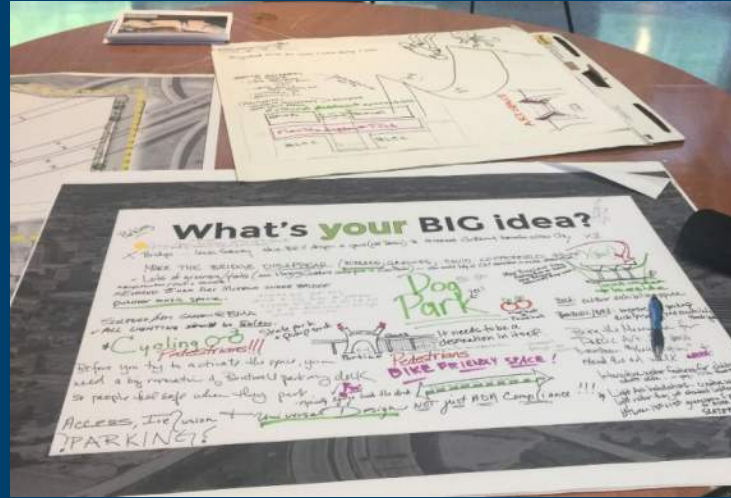

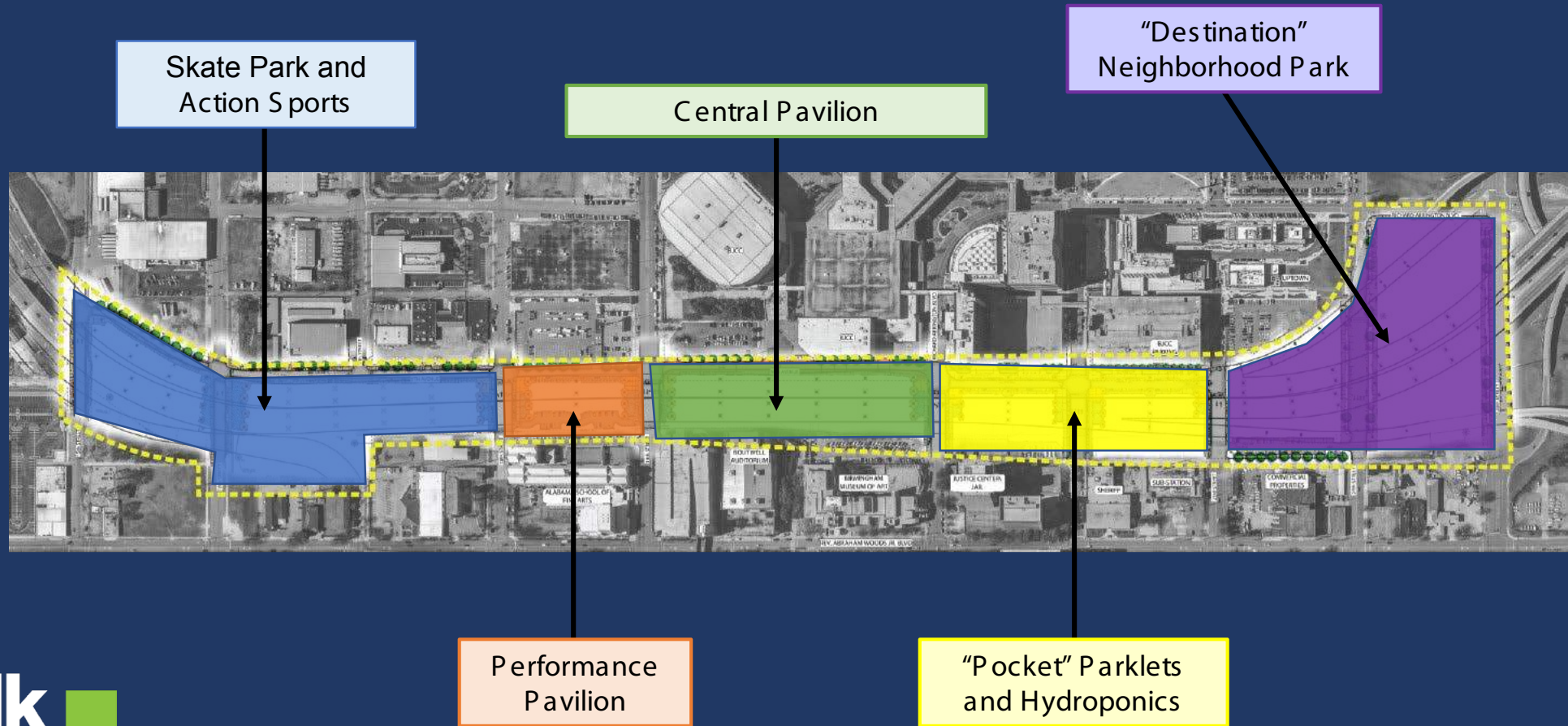


Community Workshops

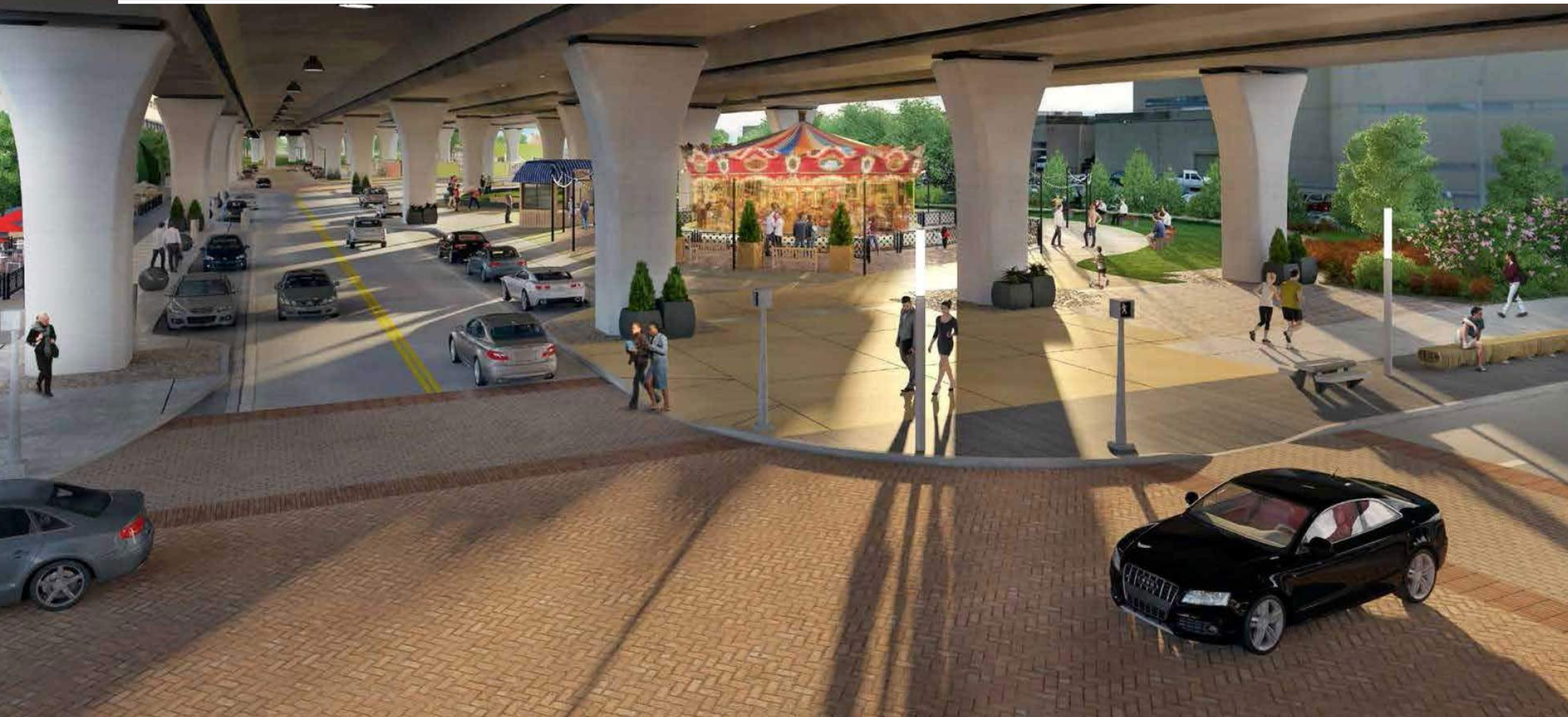

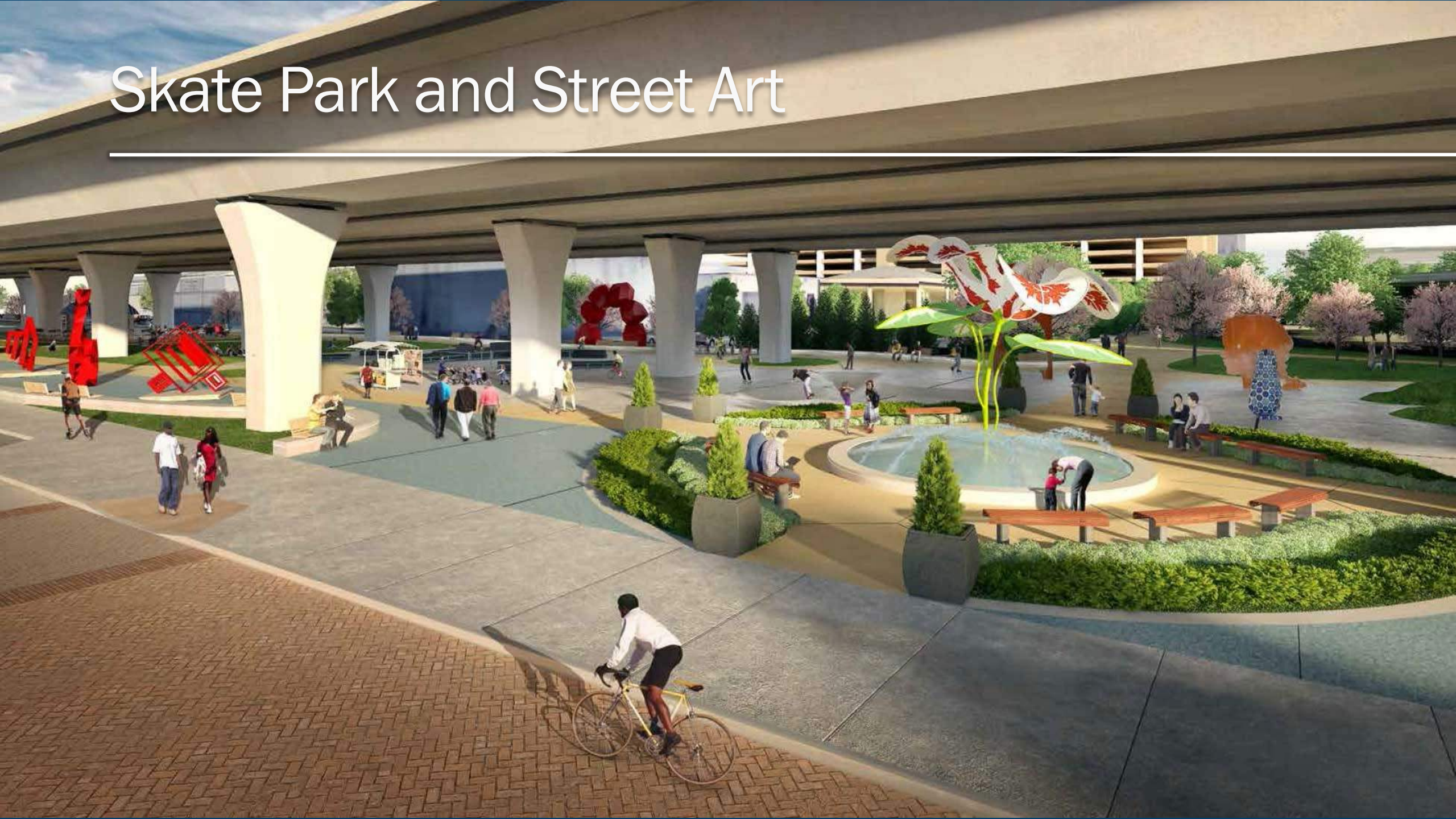
